Elementary Kids

- October - The Exodus Series is concluding (Scripture: Exodus 1-34)

The elementary kids have been going over the events of the exodus story for the past two months. In October, the series will come to an end, wrapping up the story of Moses leading the Israelites out of Egypt and to the Promised Land.

- November - The Conquering of Canaan (Scripture: Joshua 1-8)

The elementary kids will continue the Israel narrative as they learn the events of the Book of Joshua. In Joshua, the Israelites placed their trust in the Lord, and took the land He promised them. However, they experienced failures along the way. In the November, our kids will learn what it means to trust in God as He fights for us.

PK-K Kids

- October - Game Changer Series (Exodus 18 & Luke 9)

Teams are God's idea, and He wants us all on His team! Throughout this series, kids will see that playing on God's team makes life better, and they'll learn several things they can do to be great teammates.

- November - Right on Time (Scripture: Genesis 37-50)

In this series, kids will learn from the life of Joseph and see what God requires of us as we walk with Him every day. Kids will learn all about Micah 6:8 and discover that they can love God by acting justly, showing mercy, being humble, and obeying Him!

Kids Group

- October & November - The Great Outdoors

God wants to be our best friend! In this series, kids will explore the outdoors and discover how to grow in their friendship with God by getting quiet, reading His Word, opening up their hearts to Him, and worshipping. When they do those things, their friendship with God will grow, and they'll know how to follow Him!

Preteen Group

- October - Daniel (Scripture: Daniel 1-6)

The preteen group will be studying four topics out of the book of Daniel. The goal of this series is to teach our kids to remain faithful to the Lord, even with the world pressures you to conform.

- November - A Hope Is Born (Scripture: Matthew 1, Luke 2, John 1, & Romans 8)

A Hope is Born is a different way of telling the Christmas story. It compares the introduction of three Gospel books and shows the kids how the birth of Christ is the fulfillment of our hope.

Student Group

- October & November - The Book of Daniel (Scripture: Daniel 1-12)

Over the next two months, the MC3 Students will be studying the Daniel. This prophetic book is filled with historical narrative and apocalyptic literature. The students will dig into these two genres and pull out solid interpretations and applications for their daily lives. Daniel is a great book that teaches faithfulness while casted away in exile. Like the Old Testament Israelites, we too are in exile and surrounded by a dark culture. The goal of this series is to teach our students to live through that culture, but not be apart of it. It is to teach them to be something different, the light of Christ.
